

To open the translation or transliteration of a prayer while you are listening to the prayer on your computer.

- Go to the Temple Israel website: www.templeisrael-ne.org.
- On the Home Page, click on the Quick link to Cantor's Classroom.
- Double Click on the audio file of the prayer that you would like to listen to.
- The "Windows Media Player" should pop up onto your screen and start playing. Click on the STOP button.
- You want to make your "Windows Media Player" a smaller box by clicking on the arrow with a line under it on the bottom right hand corner of box to make it a compact size.
- Double click on the prayer's translation or transliteration that you want on your screen.
- After the words appear on your screen, click on the "Windows Media Player" on the bottom of your screen and the media player should appear on the screen at the top left hand corner.
- You should now have both the words and the media player on the screen.
- When you are ready to listen to the prayer, click on the PLAY button on the media player.
- When you scroll down the text, the Media player will minimize to the bottom of the screen but you should still be able to hear the prayer.

If the audio file will not open and all you get is a screen with a question mark, you will need to do the following:

- Right Click on the audio file of the prayer that you want to listen to
- Highlight "Save Target As"
- This will allow you to save this MP3 audio file on your computer.
- You will have to open the file that you just saved on your computer to be able to listen to this prayer.
